P.K. SAXENA is a Scientific Consultant - Cyber Security, Govt. of India and he was former director of one of the R&D labs of Defense Research Development Organization (DRDO) under the Ministry of Defense. Dr. Saxena, an outstanding scientist, has done his PhD on “Radical theory of near rings” from Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur. Before joining DRDO, he taught mathematics at National Institute of Technology (NIT) Silchar and National Defense Academy (NDA), Pune. Dr. Saxena has published about 80 research papers in several journals and conferences on interdisciplinary topics such as algebra, cryptology, fuzzy logic, artificial neural networks and speech technology. He has led many important R&D projects and guided many students in important engineering projects. Three scholars have received PhD degree under his supervision and several others are registered. Dr. Saxena had widely delivered talks, guest lectures, key note addresses at various forums apart from organizing international conferences as general chair. He has been in program committees of many international conferences. He has authored a book on *Cryptology* (in Hindi) which was awarded first prize by DRDO in 1997.
